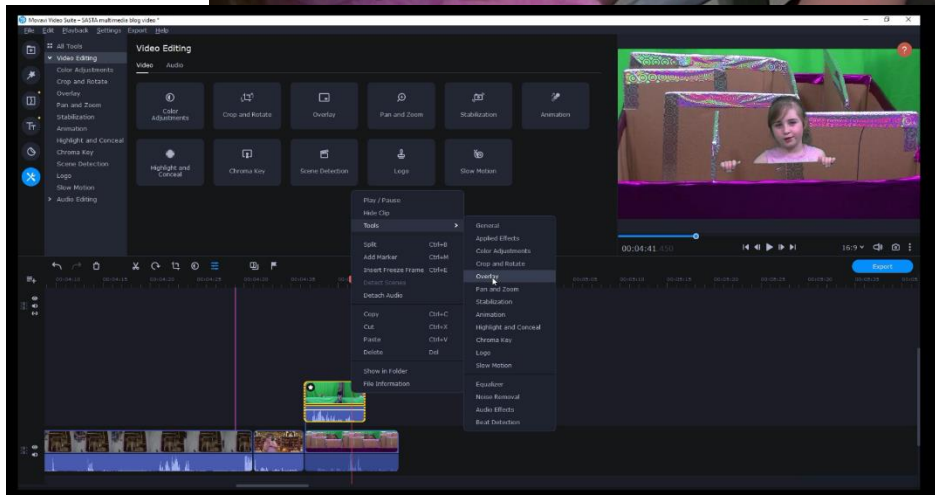
“Rat Race The Movie” By Abigail Atkinson

  - Talking in front of the camera and remembering what to say was hard. We used some flash cards to remind me when I kept forgetting.
  - The green screen was soft so I couldn't pull up on it like a real wall. We got people on each end to hold it tight. We could have used cardboard and covered it with a green screen to make it stronger.
  - The rats climbed out of the maze. Luckily we got two runs before they started climbing out. Next time I would need to make a lid for the maze.
